Honey bees, like ants, are social insects. That means, they live and work together in a bee hive.

Each type of bee has its own work to do. There is only one queen bee in a bee hive. Her job is to lay eggs. Other than this, she does nothing else.

There are only a few drones in a bee hive. They are lazy male bees. They do not work. They only mate with the queen so that she will lay eggs which will hatch into worker bees.

The royal-jelly is a special food which the worker bees make. The larvae feed on this royal-jelly for only three days. Then they are fed with pollen and honey. However, if the bees need a new queen the following year, the worker bees will select a larva and feed it only with royal-jelly.

What is fascinating about the honey bees is that the queen bee can decide how many male and female bees she needs in a hive. This is because the eggs she fertilizes will become female bees while those she does not, will become drones, the male bees. As drones are greater eaters, not many of them are found in a bee hive.
