The Dragon Boat Festival, which was originally celebrated in China, takes place yearly during the fifth month of the lunar calendar.

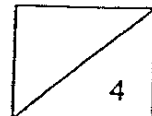

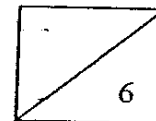
