Many different kinds of plants and animals live in the sea. Some animals are plant eaters while others are animal eaters. Among the sea creatures, the fish are best suited to live in water. Their fins and streamlined bodies help them swim well.

Some animals can live both on land and in water. The penguin is a good example. They are members of the bird family. They are birds because they lay eggs, have feathers, and are warm-blooded animals. Most birds fly, but penguins do not fly. Penguins move over land by walking, jumping and sliding using their feet and wings. They are covered with feathers which shield them from the cold. When they are in water, they use their long, flat flippers for swimming and diving. Penguins can swim well in freezing water. They have a thick layer of blubber, or fat right under their skin to keep them warm in the water.

Most penguins can dive very deep and can hold their breath for many minutes. Unlike fish, they cannot breathe underwater. They must come up to the surface of the water for air.
