Vampire Bats

The vampire bat lives in Central and South America. Though it lives only on blood, it is not a scary-looking animal. Just like other bats, the vampire bat is a mammal. Its body is covered with short grey or brown fur. Its body is only about eight centimetres long, and it has a wingspan of about thirty centimetres.

Razor-liked teeth

The bat has teeth as sharp as a razor. It uses its teeth to make a slit in the skin of its prey. Then it laps up the blood that comes out of the slit. The cut is made so skilfully that the prey may not even wake up from its sleep. Vampire bats attack their prey only at night. These bats often feed on cattle, horses and other domestic animals, though in some rare cases, vampire bats will also attack people.

Harm caused by the bats

The slit on the prey's skin heals quickly, but repeated feedings on the same animal can 10 make it weak and ill. Even more serious are the diseases that can be transmitted by the bats. Among the worst of the diseases is rabies, which often results in the death of the prey.

Habitat

Vampire bats live in colonies of about one dozen or more. During daylight hours, the nocturnal bats roost in cracks and crevices in the walls of caves. If disturbed, the bats 15 may run along the walls at surprising speed. When their wings are folded, the bats walk like a four-footed animal or hop like a frog.
