- 4. Why did Poland's nationality problems prove so intractable during the 1920s and 1930s?
- 5. Examine the relative importance of diplomatic, military, and political factors in the Polish defeat of September 1939.
- 6. Why was the political and social reconstruction of Poland in 1945 and the years following largely determined by the Soviet Union?
- 7. Explain the changing fortunes of 'national communism' in Poland between 1948 and 1980.
- 8. How was the Catholic church able to sustain such a powerful role in Communist Poland?
- 9. How much did the bouts of unrest in Poland in 1956, 1968-70, and 1980-3 have in common?
- 10. How far does the availability of sources colour our understanding of Polish politics and society in the later Communist period, 1956-89?
