3. Describe and evaluate the main arguments in favour of Florentine or Tuscan in the *questione della lingua*.

## **SECTION B**

1. How would you describe Ariosto's narrative voice, its function and effect in the *Orlando furioso*?

OR

2. How does Ariosto manage to comment on the society of his own time in a work so apparently removed from reality as the *Orlando furioso*?

OR

3. Compare the characters of Orlando and Ruggiero in the *Orlando furioso*?

## **SECTION C**

1. Which of the poets you have read would you describe as most Petrarchan and which as least Petrarchan, and why?

2. Compare the portrayal of the beloved in the poetry of Gaspara Stampa and Vittoria Colonna.

OR

3. How are men depicted in the poetry of Michelangelo, Vittoria Colonna and Veronica Franco?

OR

4. Compare the treatment of the theme of repentance by Gaspara Stampa and Michelangelo?	2
