b) To what extent can the reader identify with the characters in the short stories you have read? Answer the question with reference to three authors or collections, including at least one from before and one from after the 18th century.

c) Are short stories purely for entertainment or do they have some more serious purpose? Answer the question with reference to three authors or collections, including at least one from before and one from after the 18th century.

Section B (30%)

Briefly (4-5 lines) answer all of the following questions:

- a) What is an *exemplum*?
- b) What is a 'frame story'?
- c) Explain the statement 'l'opera d'arte sembrerà essersi fatta da sé'.
- d) Describe one of the key concepts associated with 'pirandellismo'.
