Either:

or:

b) Describe and explain the nature of Dutch public debate in the late forties and fifties on the nation's experience of the Second World War.

#### Period 2: Post-war consensus, 1945-1960s

Either:

a) Do you agree with the statement that a Catholic 'socio-cultural community' emerged in Belgium in the course of the 1960s and 1970s? Why, or why not?

or:

b) What is the relationship between pillarisation, consociation and corporatism?

#### Period 3: New issues and problems, 1960s-1980s

Either:

or:

b) Assess the relative importance of the Dutch tradition of tolerance in the making of the country's immigrant policies.

Either:

or:

b) Explain the concept of 'guide land' ('gidsland') in the current debate on Dutch national identity.
