  - Or (b) How convincing do you find Weber's analysis of the relationship between religion, capitalism and rationalization?
- 3. Either (a) ""Critical theory" extends well beyond criticism of social conditions to a re-evaluation of language and ways of thinking."

  Discuss.
  - Or (b) 'Adorno's concept of a "culture industry" was much more than an attack on modern forms of entertainment; it was an effective critique of modern societies and modern forms of communication.' Discuss.
- 4. Either (a) To what extent is Habermas' notion of 'communicative action' fundamental to his philosophy of social science?
  - Or (b) 'Habermas' distinction between "life-world" and "system" is flawed, undermining his assessment of the functioning of modern societies.' Discuss.
