- 7. 'Even the federations and party groups in the European Parliament, which come nearest to endowing the EU with a party system of its own, are more transnational than supranational.' Discuss.
- 8. Why, more than ten years after the fall of the Berlin Wall, had the EU still not accepted any country from Central and Eastern Europe as a member?
