3. ‘The law of *parité*, it is claimed, would distinguish between categories of citizens, and this is contrary to the principle of universalism of French republicanism, according to which all citizens are equal and, in political terms, the same.’ Discuss.
4. ‘Le port du foulard islamique à l’école est incompatible avec la nature laïque de l’enseignement.’ Discuss.
5. How do you account for the recent increase in support for the *Front National* among French working-class voters?

9. ‘Malgré le déplacement, l’homme maghrébin essaie de maintenir vive la pression sociale qui régit les rapports entre hommes et femmes dans son pays.’ Discuss this statement with reference to Ben Jelloun’s *Hospitalité française* AND Djura’s *Le Voile du silence*.
10. Discuss the function of the veil, literal and figurative, in *Le Voile du silence* AND *La Bataille d’Alger*.
