- 3. 'Nostalgia informs the understanding of national identity, however critical the text may initially appear.' Discuss with reference to AT LEAST TWO of the authors you have studied on this course.
- 4. 'History can never be truly "objective" or "value-free"; and particularly not in Germany, where historical consciousness is so intimately bound up with issues of national identity.' Discuss.
- 5. 'Collective identities are constantly shifting, constructed and re-constructed according to the challenges and opportunities of the moment.' Discuss with reference to gender identities in West AND / OR East Germany since 1945.
- 6. 'All conceptions of national identity depend upon notions of otherness, even if this remains unacknowledged.' Discuss with reference to AT LEAST TWO of the writers or thinkers you have studied on this course.
