- 4. 'Debates about national identity are, as often as not, an excuse for sentimental introspection.' Discuss.
- 5. 'Racism and nationalism are fundamentally different.' Discuss.
- 6. 'There is more to identity than merely the notion of an "imagined community".' Discuss.
