- 4. 'Two literary projects preoccupied Goethe throughout his lifetime: the *Wilhelm Meister* novels and *Faust*. Common to both is a sense of the ongoing dynamic and of the openendedness of modern culture.' Discuss.
- 5. 'Goethe does not disparage human experience; rather, he justifies it against all odds.' Discuss.
