- 1. 'Gottfried's prologue does not offer a reliable guide to interpreting the narrative which follows it.' Discuss.
- 2. What is the relevance of the story of Riwalin and Blanscheflur to the rest of Gottfried's romance?
- 3. 'Die Liebe Tristans und Isolts entwickelt sich nicht; sie ist mit dem Liebestrank plötzlich und unerwartet da.' Discuss.
- 4. 'Gottfried presents the episode of Isolt's wedding night in a way that discredits Marke.' Discuss.
- 5. Discuss the importance of the episode of the trial by ordeal in Gottfried's *Tristan*.
- 6. 'Although Marke spies on Tristan and Isolt in the cave of lovers episode, he is blind to the real significance of what he sees.' Discuss.
- 7. 'Flawless as Isolt might be in her service of love, she is a woman, and Gottfried's romance is insistent that perfection cannot be found in the female.' Discuss.
- 8. 'Tristan only contemplates marriage because he finds the suffering caused by his love for Isolt unendurable.' Discuss.
- 9. Discuss the function of the digressions from the main narrative in Gottfried's *Tristan*.

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
