- 7. Why were dissent and opposition so easily suppressed in the period 1953-1987?
- 8. 'The revolution of 1989 can only be explained in terms of altered international circumstances.' Discuss.
- 9. 'The SED's power was based entirely on the threat or use of Soviet force.' Discuss.
- 10. 'The GDR was a totalitarian state; we have to use the term "power" rather than "authority" when analysing the GDR.' Discuss.
