9. Examine the development of Palestinian positions on the peace process in TWO of the following areas:
 1. The status of Jerusalem
 2. The two-state solution
 3. The right of return for 1948 Palestinian refugees.
10. What, in your opinion, are the three most important books on peacemaking in either the Middle East or Northern Ireland? Defend your choices.
