- 7. How has scholarly opinion on the subject of "Vichy France and the Jews" evolved since the 1970s?
- 8. Compare and contrast the contribution to scholarship on the Holocaust of Hannah Arendt and Lucy Dawidowicz.
- 9. Compare and contrast the treatment of Jews under Nazi control in the Baltic and the Scandinavian states.
- 10. Compare and contrast the camps of Theresienstadt and Auschwitz.
- 11. Examine Hitler's presentation of his life and political development with reference to scholarly biographical work.
