- 8. Assess the significance of feminism in postwar Italy as a movement for social and cultural change.
- 9. Outline the growth of television and discuss how it affected cultural life in postwar Italy.
- 10. Assess how far the Leghe can be said to have 'invented traditions' in their pursuit of regional autonomy.
- 11. Describe and evaluate the arguments about cultural identity advanced EITHER by those opposed to immigration OR by those in favour of immigration to Italy since the 1980s.
- 12. Analyse the writings on 'mass culture' and the 'culture industry' of <u>ONE</u> author active in the postwar era.
