- 5. In what sense might the *Paradiso* be said to testify to a fresh phase in Dante's thinking in respect EITHER of the theology of election OR of ecclesiastical reform?
- 6. How are we to account for Dante's choice of Bernard of Clairvaux as his third and final guide in the *Commedia*?
- 7. Consider some of the problems encountered by Dante in conveying the substance of his final vision in the *Paradiso*. How successful was he in resolving these problems?
