- 2. The Vespa Piaggio: an exemplary case of integration between industry and design. Discuss.
- 3. Survey the work of designer Carlo Mollino, making specific reference to some examples.
- 4. The culture of Italian design in the face of increasing globalisation: describe its transformation during the last twenty years.
- 5. Italian design of the 1960s: describe the general characteristics of this period, referring to specific designers and products.
- 6. Briefly illustrate, with examples, the design process adopted by the Castiglioni brothers.
- 7. Describe the phenomenon of Radical Design, situating it in the relevant period, referring to its most important representatives and highlighting its principal characteristics.
- 8. Describe the search for lightness (*leggerezza*) in the tradition of Italian design with reference to examples of designers and products.
- 9. Identify, discuss and illustrate at least four trends in contemporary Italian design.
- 10. Using relevant examples, make a parallel between the transformation of Italian society in the 1960s and 1970s and the culture of Italian design in the same period.
- 11. Compose and describe a possible Italian domestic landscape, choosing some of the objects that have been illustrated and explained during the course.
