- 3. 'There are no stories of happy children or happy families' claims Felicity Firth of Pirandello's work. In the light of her statement examine the parent-child relationship in at least two of his plays.
- 4. 'Il piacere della storia, che è così grande' says Enrico IV. Discuss the treatment of time in *Enrico IV*.
- 5. Paolo Puppa observes that Pirandello adds an unexpected twist to the traditional motif of adultery. Comment and elaborate with reference to at least two of Pirandello's plays.
- 6. Pirandello's characters have been called 'misfits'. How appropriate do you find this definition? Discuss with reference to **two or three** of his plays.
- 7. Gramsci pointed out that the first-night audience of *Liolà* found the irresolution of the ending unsatisfactory. What seem to you to be the strengths and weaknesses of Pirandello's endings?
