- 6. 'Johannes V. Jensen's *Kongens Fald* is above all a historical novel.' How far do you agree with this statement?
- 7. 'Jakob Knudsen's *Sind* is essentially a novel about crime and punishment.' Discuss.
- 8. Of *Pelle Erobreren*. Book I (Barndom), Martin Andersen Nexø himself claimed that it showed the 'naked human being'. What might he have meant by this, and to what extent do you agree with this statement?
- 9. 'In Kaj Munk's En Idealist, King Herodes is both a cynic and a self-deceiver.' Discuss.
- 10. How far would you agree with the view that in Fiskerne Hans Kirk ridicules religion?
