- 4. Compare and contrast the nature of enlightened absolutism in Denmark and Sweden during the last three decades of the eighteenth century.
- 5. Account for the outbreak of war between Britain and Denmark in 1801 and 1807.
- 6. Why was Gustaf IV Adolf of Sweden overthrown in 1809?
- 7. 'The events of 1814 prompted rather than reflected the emergence of Norwegian national identity'. Discuss.
- 8. Why did Denmark lose Schleswig-Holstein in 1864?
- 9. Examine the role of 'push' and 'pull' factors in mass emigration from ANY ONE Scandinavian country between c. 1860 and 1914.
- 10. Examine the internal and external pressures to which ANY TWO Scandinavian countries were subjected during the First World War.
- 11. What were the political consequences of the Great Depression in ANY TWO Scandinavian countries?
- 12. 'A tainted neutrality.' To what extent is this a fair description of Swedish foreign policy during the Second World War?
- 13. Compare the effectiveness of the resistance movements in Denmark and Norway during the Second World War.
- 14. Why did Norway join NATO in 1949?
