- 3. Why were the social democratic parties so dominant in Scandinavia during the period 1945-1965?
- 4. How have the Scandinavian social democratic parties attempted to respond to the political challenges, from right and left, during the last twenty years?

- 5. Assess the relative contributions of European socialist thought and Scandinavian political influences to the ideological development of Scandinavian social democracy.
- 6. In what ways has the trade union movement influenced the development of the Scandinavian social democratic parties during the twentieth century?
- 7. In what ways did social democratic parties attempt to construct an alternative culture during the interwar period?
- 8. For what reasons was Scandinavian social democracy seen as a 'middle way' by foreign commentators between the 1930s and the 1970s?
