- 1. Discuss the pros and cons of Content Management Systems for website management and development. What factors might influence an organisation's decision to use a CMS? Give examples (specific or generic) of both appropriate and inappropriate situations for CMS usage, and explain your reasoning.
- 2. Explain the role of a DTD in an XML environment. What mechanisms are used in a DTD to control the markup and structure of an XML application?
- 3. Why are issues of accessibility important in website design? How might a designer achieve accessibility in a website?
- 4. Why is a knowledge of how search engines work important when designing a website? How can designers use knowledge of how search engines work to improve the chance of a user finding their sites? Is it more important to understand how the technology works, or the psychology of the users? Why? State your point of view and give your reasons.
- 5. Explain the principles behind, and differences between CSS, XSL, and XML Schemas for control of look and feel aspects of web documents.
- 6. Are modern web design tools and environments which encourage a WYSIWYG approach to building web pages a good thing? Do they have any potential drawbacks? Discuss the pros and cons of the use of such tools.
- 7. Why do so many websites fail to succeed? What makes a website successful? Discuss, ensuring you address issues which have positive and negative impacts on success.
