- 6. What are the key features of graphics use for the web? Discuss both the technical aspects of different types of web graphics and their advantages and disadvantages in use, and also the role and usage of graphics in web pages in general.
- 7. Explain the typical functions of a CMS (Content Management System) and discuss what kinds of website might derive most benefit from utilizing this kind of management approach. When would it **not** be appropriate to use a CMS?
