Essays may be written in either Spanish or English, but no extra credit will be given for answers in Spanish. Candidates should not base more than ONE answer on a particular work. Candidates should not base their answers on any text or texts used extensively in their course-work essays.

1. EITHER a) 'The more we speculate, the more perplexed we become.' Discuss this view in relation to Borges's stories.
