- 1. Examine what you think Poe meant by a short story by Borges or by Cortázar having 'the soul of the reader at the writer's control'.
- 2. How realistic are Borges and Cortázar as short-story writers?
- 3. Explain what you think Borges means, in his stories, by the 'nadería de la personalidad'.
- 4. Borges said that he learnt to become a sceptical reader. What would a sceptical reading of his stories tell us?
- 5. Borges wrote of one story that 'es posible leerlo como directa narración de hechos novelescos y también de otro modo'. Assess what he means by 'otro modo' in AT LEAST ONE story.
- 6. 'Borges's "fictions" convey no message and a sense of isolation and nihilism.' Discuss.
- 7. 'Cortázar's stories deal with "bad faith".' Discuss.
- 8. Cortázar's stories attempt to shock the reader, but to what purpose?
- 9. 'Cortázar's narrators are limited, devious, unaware.' Discuss.
- 10. Why do you think that Cortázar dismisses the anecdote of a story as not relevant?
