Candidates should answer TWO questions.

Essays may be written in Spanish or English, but no extra credit will be given for answers in Spanish.

Candidates should not normally base their answers on any text or texts (except in the case of Don Quijote) used extensively in their course-work essays.

- 1. 'What Cervantes did was to posit the problem of the book, and of its influence on life' (Leo Spitzer). Discuss this view of *Don Quijote*.
- 2. Discuss the role played by the theme of Dulcinea in the structure and the meaning of Don Quijote.
- 3. What are the main differences between Part I and Part II of *Don Quijote*? Why do you think Cervantes made the changes he did?
- 4. Discuss and explain the function of ONE of the following in *Don Quijote*: irony; the *cueva de Montesinos* and *Clavileño* episodes; madness.
- 5. Examine the role of the narrator(s) in ANY TWO of the *Novelas Ejemplares* you have studied. (You may take *El casamiento engañoso* and *El coloquio de los perros* to be either one single, or two separate *novelas*.)
- 6. 'La gitanilla in the end equates only the nobility with exemplary moral behaviour. Cervantes's message in this novela ejemplar is a conservative one.' Discuss.
- 7. 'The whole novela is constructed round the *cuestiones de amor*' (Jennifer Thompson). How far do you agree with this reading of Cervantes's *Las dos doncellas*? Justify your answer.
- 8. To what extent would you say that the *Novelas ejemplares* prove that experience is the best teacher? Refer to ONE or MORE *novelas* in your answer.
