Question 1

Translate the following passage into Spanish

During his secret holiday in Chennai, the famous author Salman Rushdie might have managed to visit the tourist destination of Mahabalipuram. Rushdie, who lived incognito for several years in the West after the Iranian leader Ayatollah Khomeini ordered the death penalty against him for insulting Islam in his book 'Satanic Verses', had possibly visited these places in disguise.
