Essays may be written in either Spanish or English, but no extra credit will be given for answers in Spanish. Candidates should not base more than ONE answer on a particular work. Candidates should not base their answers on any text or texts used extensively in their course-work essays.

- 1. 'In his fiction, Juan Goytisolo is more concerned with testimony than with invention.' To what extent does *Señas de identidad* confirm this observation?
- 2. 'What is too often overlooked in discussions of *Ultimas tardes con Teresa* is the fact that the work is, above all else, a humorous novel.' Discuss.
- 3. Discuss the treatment of fantasy, memory, and history in El cuarto de atrás.
- 4. 'Las mujeres viven el mundo de forma muy diferente a los hombres y se ven obligadas a contarlo de forma a menudo radicalmente distinta' (Rosa Montero). Examine Montero's *Crónica del desamor* in the light of these observations.
- 5. 'La lluvia amarilla is an attempt to come to terms with the past, to attempt to know it and retain it, in the face of a desperate present.' Discuss this assessment of Llamazares's novel.
- 6. Compare the treatment of the rural OR urban environment in ANY TWO of the works studied.
- 7. 'En la novela moderna no hay verdades absolutas, sino parcialidad, ambigüedad, relativismo.' Discuss with reference to AT LEAST ONE of the works studied.
- 8. Examine the theme of alienation OR isolation in AT LEAST ONE of the works studied.
- 9. Compare the way historical OR political reality is developed in AT LEAST TWO of the works studied.
- 10. 'La novela la ejecuta el lector.' Discuss with reference to AT LEAST ONE of the works studied.
