5. Give an analytical account of the relationships between civil-military bureaucracy and the domestic private business sector, domestic civil society and international business based in industrialised countries. Your analysis should focus on Africa, Asia or Latin America.
6. Are NGOs a source of independent public action and a distinctive type of development agent or just 'public service contractors'?
7. Discuss the following statement: "The Chilean neo-liberal model implemented since 1975 has been a 'major success' both as development administration and economic development".
8. What, in your view, should be the most important features of an approach to development administration seeking to improve the standards of living of the whole society?
