PART B

- 3. It is claimed that the cost of security provided by the state is diminished individual freedom. Do you agree? Illustrate your answer with examples.
- 4. 'Some theories relating to the functioning of societies (and economies) seek to explain, some to justify and some to predict'. Consider these claims with respect to Marxist theory.

PART C

- 5. Quantitative indicators of poverty hide more than they reveal and are of little use to policy makers. Discuss with examples.
- 6. Assess the value of the 'sustainable livelihoods approach' as both a tool of analysis and for informing anti-poverty interventions. Discuss.
- 7. While the principles underlying a rights-based approach may be correct, the problem lies in their operationalisation. Discuss. Provide examples to illustrate your answer.
