Discuss this statement from the point of view of one planning approach of your choice.
- 3. Compare the treatment of rationality in the rational comprehensive approach to planning and the communicative approach to planning.
- Take a case of your choice and identify the approach to planning in it, discussing its underlying assumptions about society, the state and planning.
- Compare the treatment of participation in two planning approaches of your choice. Give examples to illustrate your arguments.
- Discuss the relationship between urban planning, urban management and urban governance. Use examples to illustrate your arguments.
