Discuss and explain the likely similarities and differences between consultations conducted by the 2 doctors.
- 3. Maya, a 15 year old girl comes with her mother (who was born in Africa) to see the general practitioner. Maya says she has "inflammation between her legs". Summarise the issues this presentation raises and discuss methods and skills the GP may need to employ to optimise his/her chances of achieving a successful consultation.
- 4. The local PCT is interested in evaluating the quality of GP consultations. Discuss the features of high quality consultations in general practice illustrating your answers with examples from consultations you have witnessed. Summarise the methods that the PCT may use to evaluate the quality of GP consultations.
