- 1. List the factors that can contribute to tinnitus becoming a problem. Briefly describe how a hearing therapist may enable an individual with problem tinnitus to break the cycle of distress and manage impact of the tinnitus.
- 2. Devise a leaflet of communication strategies for an individual with a hearing loss in order to enable them to maximise communication on a day to day basis. This leaflet will be used as part of a rehabilitation process.
- 3. In a speech and language therapy assessment what communication difficulties might you find in (a) a patient with a profound congenital hearing loss and (b) a patient with a profound acquired hearing loss?
- 4. Define and discuss the outcome measures used to evaluate vestibular compensation.
- 5. What is counselling, who seeks it and why? What are the core qualities required in order to establish a successful counselling relationship.
- 6. Describe how a patient with a hearing loss can access additional equipment for use in the home, workplace and educational environment. List the categories of technical equipment and human aids currently available.

- 1. Describe the current role of hearing therapy in the management of adults with hearing loss and associated conditions, outlining the services hearing therapy can provide?
